Eastern Cabarrus Heritage Baking Competition Saturday, December 2 on the grounds of ECHS

Overview

The Eastern Cabarrus Heritage Bake-off seeks your finest made-from-scratch home-baked goods made from recipes and/or techniques that are at least 50 years old.

The competition will comprise the following categories:

Pastry
Cakes

Cookies
Artisan Breads

Sweet Breads

A winner will be chosen in each category as well as an overall grand champion.

There is no fee to enter the bake-off, but ECHS asks that you prepare two of each entry – one to be judged and one to be auctioned to raise funds for ECHS. Please include a list of ingredients with the item to be auctioned.

Contest Requirements & Guidelines

- All entries must be made-from-scratch recipes that are at least 50 years old.
- Each entry will be shown in a display that connects the recipe to its past. For example, a photograph of the grandmother who gave you the recipe, her rolling pin, or handwritten notes. Be creative as the story behind the recipe and its presentation will be considered in the judging.
- If possible, include the recipe in the original form in which you received it (3x5 card, diary, back of envelope, heirloom cookbook, etc.) in your display.
- Each entry must include the recipe's history: who passed it down to you, its ethnicity (if applicable), number of years it's been in your family, traditions involving the recipe, etc.
- Participants may enter 1 item per category
- No entries requiring refrigeration will be allowed.
- Pre-registration is encouraged, it is not required. All participants must submit their forms by noon on Saturday, December 2, when set-up may begin.
- Judging will be at 1 p.m. and winners will be announced immediately following the conclusion of the judges' deliberations.
- The silent auction for all entries will begin at noon and conclude at 3:00 p.m.
