



## *ECHS Christmas Market Rules and Regulations*

The Eastern Cabarrus Historical Society Christmas Market rules and regulations are intended to be fair and to uphold the purpose of the market as a local producer/arts-and-crafts product oriented market.

**TIME AND PLACE:** The Christmas Market will operate on Saturday, December 7 from noon to 3:00 p.m. at 1100 North Main St., Mt. Pleasant. ECHS reserves the right to change hours of operation or cancel the market due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

**FEES:** There is no fee, but registration is required to participate.

**WHO CAN SELL:** Vendors may sell at the market only after completing an application and receiving approval from the ECHS. ECHS reserves the right to reject any application for any reason, and may limit the number of approved applications if there is a need to control the market size.

**APPLICATION PROCESS:** All sellers wishing to sell at the market must submit their application to ECHS for approval prior to selling at the market. All sellers must have a copy of their approved permit on-site when attending the market.

**MARKETING ASSISTANCE:** ECHS will make every effort to publicize the market through its website and Facebook page. All publicity of the market and vendors is at the discretion of ECHS, and the approval of an application does not guarantee that such information will be publicized by ECHS.
